In this class, you will learn:

- **to create** a variety of pottery forms using the potter's wheel, slab roller, extruder, and your bare hands!
- **to decorate** raw clay through carving, incising, applique, stamping, and altering.
- **to apply** color to clay with stains, slips and underglazes.
- **to glaze** pottery by dipping, pouring and painting.
- **to analyze** and discuss pottery forms through group critique, using a knowledge of pottery concepts and the basic elements and principles of design.
- **to interpret** your own work in relation to both historic and contemporary examples.

About the Instructors:

Jeff & Jane Boswell have a 35-year history with teaching, with clay, and with each other. Jane taught pottery at Jefferson High School; Jeff, also a single teacher, signed up for her adult education class, and the rest is history. Both have done graduate work in pottery and have enjoyed exhibiting and selling their work.

Natalie Powell is a graduate of the Jeff High Pottery program and Indiana University where she majored in pottery and graphic design. Natalie and the Boswells enjoy working together and have collaborated on pottery and design projects for many years.
